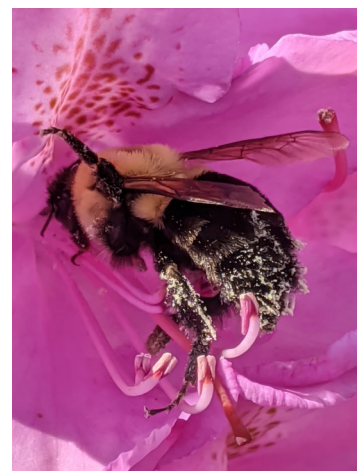

Region XI selected Knickers for New Life as the convention project for 2021 to honor the 10 year partnership with Schools for Africa. 100% of the donations will go to this charity!

Thousands of girls in Uganda miss a week of school every month. Without access to basic sanitary products, many girls are forced to quit school. Without an education, they are faced with a life of poverty, disease and HIV, child marriage/teen pregnancy and are at greater risk for human trafficking.

KFNL partners with one school at a time in Uganda. Providing knickers (underwear), sanitary supplies, separate latrines for girls and boys, handwash stations, and mosquito-repellant soap. **A girl's needs for the year can be met for \$35 – a small investment with a big impact!** Every year that a girl stays in school will increase her socio-economic prospects for the rest of her life.
